WHAT ARE THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE BILLET FAMILY?

Billet family responsibilities are to provide the player with essential needs:

Food • Shelter • Bed • Utilities • Laundry Facilities • Complete registration per USA Hockey requirements

Players are to provide their own personal items such as toiletries (shaving cream, shampoo, deoderant, etc.) as well as pocket money (personal entertainment, eating out, etc.), transportation to the airport for personal travel, etc. The billet family is never to provide cash to the player.

ARE BILLET FAMILIES COMPENSATED?

YES - Billet families will receive a stipend each month to help cover the costs associated with feeding and housing their player.

ARE BILLET FAMILIES RESPONSIBLE FOR DRIVING PLAYERS TO SCHOOL & PRACTICES?

NO - Players will either have their own transportation, or transportation will be arranged for them by the team. It is never the expectation that the billet family transport their player.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I HAVE TO TRAVEL DURING THE TIME THAT THE PLAYER IS IN MY HOME?

If you need to be away at any time, we will make arrangements for your player to stay with a teammate until you return.

TEAM RULES & EXPECTATIONS

THE OMAHA MASTERY AAA HOCKEY CLUB IS A ZERO TOLERANCE HOCKEY CLUB.

- Players have a 9:30 PM curfew on school nights and an 11:00 PM curfew on weekends, unless otherwise stated.
- Use of alcohol or illegal drugs is strictly prohibited.
- Tobacco of any kind is prohibited.

- Players are not to leave the Omaha area without prior approval from their coach.
- No female guests are allowed in billet homes.
- Grades must be held at an acceptable level.

THE COACHING STAFF IS VERY STRICT AND VIGILANT IN ENSURING THAT TEAM RULES ARE FOLLOWED BY OUR PLAYERS.
